

Graduate Student Assistant Position for Spring 2010

Job Description:

Assistant to undergraduate upper division hematology class instructor, Dr. Leslie Tobler, during laboratory period held once a week on Fridays from 9.00 a.m. to 12.30 p.m. Duties include set-up and break down of labs, equipment organization and aliquoting of samples, assisting students in cell identification, grading quizzes and lab exercises. The job calls for five hours a week at \$13.80/hr. This class presents an excellent way to experience clinical laboratory hematological procedures and is a requirement for entry into the Clinical Laboratory Science program at SFSU.

Criteria and Skills:

This position requires a classified graduate student enrolled in a minimum of 3 units with a gpa of 3.00 or better, preferably from biology or the health sciences or a laboratory/clinical field. While a background in hematology is not essential, the assistant should be familiar with cell morphology and the use of a microscope. Basic computer skills are helpful in generating quizzes. The applicant should have good communication skills.
